




Stewardship

September has come and gone at the farm! The Gathering Area is being put to great use. The new Youth Ambassador cohort has begun with 7 youths. They will meet multiple times per month in the Gathering Area. Alexis Moreno and her Girl Scout troop planted berries and worked in the native garden. Marigolds were planted for Dia de los Muertos. Many of these flowers were distributed to our local community members and should be blooming soon.

The planting and harvesting continues. Tomatoes, cucumbers, eggplant, zucchini, squash, green beans and swiss chard to name a few. Extra produce was bagged and distributed to community members with food insecurity. The mission of Our Saviour's and CRECE Urban Farms through Grace Community Farm is working. We are making a difference in the lives of people!

The highlight of the month was our first Farm to Table dinner. CRECE staff, Grace Farm team and the Fellowship Committee worked together for a great event. Over 60 people attended and the food was fantastic. Many thanks to Steve Anticona from CRECE and Chris Kopczynski for doing the majority of the cooking. The Swiss chard pie, pumpkin soup, caprese salad, pesto pasta, pasta prima vera and pumpkin cake were absolutely delicious.

Saturday volunteer hours are from 8:30am to 1:30pm and there will be a demonstration/ activity at 10:30am. Please feel free to come to the farm to volunteer, or just to sit and enjoy the farm.
