Last month I reported that the Synod office had identified a Pastor that we could share as interim for both OSLC and Christ Lutheran. We met with him a couple of times and it all seemed very positive. However, he determined that the shared ministry position at OSLC and Christ Lutheran was not the right fit for him at this time and subsequently declined to move ahead in this process. Yes, we are disappointed, but we know that God has someone out there for us and that person will eventually turn up. Continue to keep the process in your prayers. In the meantime, thanks to Jan Johnson for coordinating supply Pastors.

The council unanimously voted this month to send \$250 from the church to the Synod for Lutheran Disaster Relief for the Maui fire/disaster. The council also voted to go forward with Elite Roofing for the roof replacement after the congregation approved applying for a loan on August 6th. It is a good thing that we are progressing as we had two more leaks during hurricane Hillary's rain. Elite roofing has ordered all the material which is due in the next couple of weeks and then will start the reroofing. It should be completed by the end of September. As I have shared, the cost will be \$86,800. To date we have received \$24,100 for the job, which means the loan will not have to be what originally projected. Thanks to all who have contributed to date and of course contributions can still be made. Make the check out to OSLC and mark it for reroofing.

Long time church member Helen Warner will be celebrating her 100th birthday September 3rd. We are encouraging everyone to send her a card, a card shower for the 100th. I am told her daughters are planning to bring her to church Sunday September 3 where we can sing to her.




