We continue to work with the synod office to obtain an interim pastor to share with Christ Lutheran. Our Bishop, Dave Nagler, shared with us that there is a shortage of pastors. For every 6 retiring pastors there is only one graduating. Thus, the difficulty in obtaining an interim. Continue to pray for OSLC and the process.

The door on our dumpster building gave way this past month. A replacement had to be built and installed. Rather than it being an old-style single panel garage door it is now two gates with a latch. It works really well and cost \$750. The roof on the church has some spot leaks. We have hired a person to do two repairs on the flat gravel roof over the office. Also, as the age of the shingles on the church are getting old and bubbly, we are getting quotes to replace the roof. This number is going to be a big number considering to reroof a house is in excess of \$20k. Our church needs care to keep it in good condition.

This past month we also had some vandalism on our property. Not sure why people think it is fun to break off a sprinkler value, but they do. I received a call from the Orange Police that we had "ole faithful" shooting high into the sky. I went off to the church and shut it down and replaced the broken valve. Additionally, we are having young kids doing "donuts" with their vehicles on the grass area by the parking area. If any of you see people doing stuff to our property they should not be doing, please call the police and report it. We will be putting in a couple more surveillance cameras for the parking lot to hopefully reduce the vandalism but that is not fool proof. Again, please be alert when at the church and report any problem that you see.

# Our Saviour's Children's Center


