

Presidents Message

Hi all, the first month of 2023 has flown by and now it is February. I hope you all have recovered from the Christmas holidays and had a Happy New Year.

Yes, I am back again as your president. Guess I am like a bad penny, I just keep coming back. Seriously, OSLC is very special, and I am glad to be a member and back to serve as your president.

The council had their first meeting on January 16th and had much to discuss. During the Council meeting I was elected to serve as President, Jan Johnson was Vice-President, Carol Youngman Secretary, Treasure-Bob Hunter, and Financial Secretary-Kathleen Berg for 2023. A huge thank-you goes to Steven Yoshizumi who was President for the past year as he led OLSC through a challenging year. Pastor Jennifer was just not a fit for OSLC and now we are utilizing supply Pastors for the time being until we are able to call another Pastor. Our Pacifica Synod Bishop Dave Nagler and his Orange County assistant Pastor Jennifer Schultz were at the council meeting to discuss the outlook for obtaining a Pastor. They shared that Christ Lutheran Church located on La Veta and Wheeler in Orange, is also looking for a Pastor and like us can only afford a part-time Pastor. They recommended that we discuss the possibility of hiring a full time Pastor between the two churches. To make this happen we would need to have a couple of our folks meet with a couple of their folks to get the process started. After the Bishop and his assistant left the meeting, the council discussed their recommendation and agreed that we should pursue this. Steven Yoshizumi and Christine Garcia were elected to be the OSLC representatives to work with Christ Lutheran. Steven contacted Pastor Jennifer Schultz and told her OSLC is on board. Steven and Christine are waiting to hear back from Pastor Jennifer Schultz when she has the meeting set up with Christ Lutheran. Pray for Steven & Christine as they work this and pray for OSLC as we go forward with this.

Jan Johnson shared that she has supply Pastors set for all the Sundays now through April. Thank you, Jan! What then was discussed was lent. Ash Wednesday is February 22, the last Wednesday of February. It was decided that we will not have a service but encourage all to go to a service in another church in the area. We will be having Lenten-soup-suppers the five March Wednesdays. Sign-ups to bring soup will be put out in the next couple of weeks.

Committee liaison assignments of the council were also done during the meeting. See them in that section of the newsletter. With committee liaison assignments, brought up the discussion of volunteerism by our congregational members. We encourage all to take part in a committee if you can. If you want to learn more about what they do, contact the council liaison person. Also, as stated in the bulletin each week, volunteers are needed each Sunday morning for the church service. Sign-up sheets are in the narthex. I encourage all of you, if you have any questions concerning the church, the church committees, etc., please contact a council member.

Our Saviour's Children's center preschool office, toddler room, and infant rooms have completed renovation. New flooring was put down, new sinks were installed along with new cabinets and painting done. They were fortunate to have two donors fund this effort. These rooms are now looking good and in great working order. I encourage all to go take a look. Also concerning the preschool, the wrought iron fence posts around the toddler yard in front of Hansen Hall have rusted out and need replacing.

Additionally, it has been decided that for safety reasons a wrought iron fence needs to be built from the NW corner of the church to the east side of the Moreland Hall entrance doors. A keyed gate will be installed between the wall and the red brick wall with the school's sign. This will cost \$8,200. The council authorized Bob to obtain a loan to pay for this from the Mission Investment Fund, an arm of the ELCA. This is the same place the church borrowed funds for the solar panels years back.

Before closing, thank you again to Steven for serving as President this past year. Also thank you to outgoing council member Kristen Tolentino for her service the past three years serving as secretary for two of them. Welcome aboard to new council members Jeanine Singer, Melissa Pool & Carol Youngman. And thank you to council members Jan Johnson, Heather Wilkens, Bob Hunter, Christine Garcia & Violet Yoshizumi for continuing to serve on council. Sadly, Lawton Miller who was serving and had just been re-elected to council passed in January and is now with our Lord. Thank you, Lawton, for your service and dedication to OLSC and we are praying for your family.

I am looking forward to a great year at OSLC to "SHINE" and share the light of Jesus Christ!"


Happy Valentine's Day!


