Then the following Sunday there will be a special congregational meeting to vote whether or not to call him. Another important Sunday for all to be there. With the vote being positive for him to be called, he would then start as Pastor of OSLC on the 1st of February. Keep all this in your prayers as we move forward.

On December 3rd we approved our 2024 spending plan at Part I of our congregational meeting. Yes, it is a deficit budget as typical. Every year I have been a member of OSLC we have always come through each year meeting all our obligations. We also elected three council members. Nelly Walker, Jon Davis, and Christine Garcia. These three are replacements for council members whose terms completed in December: Heather Wilkens, Lawton Miller, and Christine Garcia. Part II of the annual congregational meeting will be on Sunday January 21. As is our tradition there will be a pot luck after church followed by the meeting for a review of 2023 and looking forward to 2024. Reports are due to the church office, Melissa Pool, by Monday January 8 for inclusion in the 2023 annual report. Hope all of you will participate in that also.

Last November I reported that the council has been looking into the possibility of converting our open space to the west of Moreland Hall into a community garden and that Nelly Walker is spear heading the effort. That effort is progressing and looking good. OSLC received an anonymous gift of \$8,000 to help make that happen. Thank you to that person. Stay tuned to see the progress.

I have to mention again, that I hope everyone has taken a second look at our new church roof with the new skylights over the altar. I think it makes the church look like a whole new building. The price tag was just over \$91,000, but OSLC was able to afford it with the many contributions for the roof of \$28,071 given directly or as memorials in memory of Heather Wilkens (Thanks to all who have contributed) and the loan OSLC obtained from the ELCA Mission Investment funds of \$67,000. A big thank you to Bob Hunter our church treasurer who completed the necessary paper work for the loan.

Want to also mention again that during our Great Thanksgiving feast on Sunday November 12th we raised over \$1,000 for Lutheran Disaster Response, in particular the Maui disaster. Again, thanks to all who contributed.

Looking forward to the "meet & greet" with Pastor Scott on January 7th and then the vote the following Sunday, January 14th. See you all there.


